1. IMPORTANT NOTE TO ALL SELECTED APPLICANTS

All selected applicants are required to read, understand and abide by these instructions outlined below.

1.1.All selected applicants are required to confirm through NACTE website i.e <u>www.nacte.go.tz</u> through the link "uthibitisho TAMISEMI" from the announced date to 15th August; abide of doing so the opportunity will be given to other applicant.

2. DATE OF ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

All selected students are required to report at **TaSUBa** from **Monday 15th November 2020** to **Tuesday November 27th at** 9.00 a.m. Registration will commence on the same day 15th **November 2020 to Tuesday March 27th** 2020

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

All selected applicants shall be registered after fulfillment of the following:

A. FEES PAYMENT

- i. Bring the **original pay in slip** with you. Cheque, cash, faxes, scanned pay in slips; emails of confirmation of payments and any other form of payments are not acceptable.
- ii. Fees paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the Institute without permission of the Principal. The approval permission has to be submitted to the Principal's office within two weeks from the commencement of the academic year:
 - 50% will be refunded for those who apply within two weeks from commencement of the academic year.
 - No refund after two weeks of the commencement of the academic year.
- iii. No student shall be allowed to register or attend classes unless the required fees and costs have been paid as per fees/costs structure instructions.

B. DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

i. Students shall be registered under the names appearing in the Certificates submitted for the application.

4. ACOMMODATION AND HOSTEL FACILITIES

- You are cautioned that TaSUBa has limited accommodation facilities.
- Policy of TaSUBa is both On-campus and Off-campus. Most students stay Offcampus. Off-campus students have to take care of their accommodation arrangements.
